Sowing Instructions



Start indoors for an early crop, preferably as soon as possible (Feb onwards). However, they can be grown directly outside after threat of frost has passed.



Keep soil moist during germination, and ensure the soil is also well-drained. Pick from the bottom up when heads mature.



Ensure you do not grow these plants in the same areas that other members of the cabbage family were grown the year previous.

Days to harvest to maturity

130 days.

Tips

Harvest sprouts from the bottom of plant up as their heads mature.
