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Sowing Instructions



Planting seeds around 1/4 inch below surface level, spaced 1/2 inch apart. Grow in a light and sunny location.



Is quite hardy, allowing to be sown as soon as the soil is pliable. Best direct seeded to a depth of 1/8 inch, and firm soil gently or alternatively start under cover in plugs.



Germinates 7-14 days from seed, depending on conditions provided. Transplanting bare roots is not recommended as the plants can go into shock and bolt to seed.

Days to harvest to maturity

140 days.

Tips

Sow seeds every 2 to 3 weeks for a continuous supply of crops throughout the season.
