Carrot Lunar White is a white carrot variety. This unique crop can be a mix of cream white and green toward the top of the plant. A nearly coreless type with a mild flavour. Can grow up to 12 inches when fully mature, but can also be grown as a baby carrot if you prefer.

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Sowing Instructions



Till the bed deeply when the soil is dry. Sow the seeds directly outside into shallow holes and cover lightly with soil.



Carrots do not transplant well, so sowing directly outdoors is always advised. Thin seedlings carefully to 2cm apart, watering beforehand to avoid disturbing nearby roots.



Grow crops under horticultural fleece to avoid carrot fly attacks. Will mature roughly 68 days from germination.

Tips

These seeds can be left in the ground through winter or lifted and packed into boxes of damp sand, where they'll stay good as new for months.
