Sowing Instructions



Till the bed deeply when the soil is dry. Sow the seeds directly outside into shallow holes and cover lightly with soil.



Carrots do not transplant well, so sowing directly outdoors is always advised. Thin seedlings carefully to 2cm apart, watering beforehand to avoid disturbing nearby roots.



Grow crops under horticultural fleece to avoid carrot fly attacks. Will mature roughly 68 days from germination.

Days to harvest to maturity

70-90 days.

Tips

These seeds can be left in the ground through winter or lifted and packed into boxes of damp sand, where they'll stay good as new for months.
