Sowing Instructions



Sow seeds from January to February under glass, or from March to April directly outside in position.



To sow indoors, place seeds sideways roughly 1cm deep in pots or trays filled with compost. Harden off indoor grown seedlings from April, planting out to 25-30cm apart.



When sowing directly outside, do so thinly in drills that are spaced 30cm apart. Water regularly, especially in dry periods.

Days to harvest to maturity

120-130 days.

Tips

This leek is super hardy and can be planted as soon as the soil can be worked.
