Sowing Instructions



Start inside from February to March or directly outside from April to August.



Sow in regular 3 week intervals for a continuous crop. When transplanting, clip plants to 5-7cm and plant 5cm deep.



Ensure the soil is moist and fertile, as this will produce the best crop. No thinning required.

Days to harvest to maturity

180 days.
