Sowing Instructions



Start seeds on a warm windowsill in early spring. Pop a single seed 1 in deep per pot. Gradually acclimatise to the outdoors after all risk of frost has passed.



Alternatively, you can plant seeds directly outside after the soil becomes warmer in late spring.



Ensure plants have support to ramble by using canes or netting.

Tips

Pick runner beans regularly throughout their harvestable period to encourage new ones to grow.
