Sowing Instructions



Sow seeds 1-2cm deep in 4cm pots with seed compost. Keep soil moist. Seedlings will grow over an average of 10-21 days.



Transplant seedlings into their own containers when they have at least two pairs of leaves.



Keep moist and feed regularly when in fruit with top quality tomato feed.

Days to harvest to maturity

70 days.

Tips

Needs full sun and warmth to germinate. Can be grown in a heated greenhouse or conservatory.
